REGULATIONS:

The International Championship will be governed by the CISM Regulations Edition 2011 and the CISM Military Pentathlon Regulations Edition 2016.

The shooting event will be conducted at a distance of 50 meters with small bore rifle (.22LR) to be provided by the hosting country together with the ammunition.

ELIGIBILITY:

According to the CISM Regulations Edition 2011, competitors must be military personnel on active duty within the armed forces of their respective country with an up to date military identity card.

UNIFORM:

Service uniform is required for the Opening Ceremony, the Closing Ceremony and all other official occasions.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS:

Information concerning passports, visas, vaccinations, and health regulations can be obtained from the Belarus Embassy or Consulate in your country or visit the web site <u>www.mfa.gov.by</u>.

Applications for visas and for the transportation of weapons and ammunition are the responsibility of the participating delegations.

BOARD AND LODGING:

During their stay in the republic of Belarus the delegations are guests of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Belarus from 19th to 24th June 2017. Board and lodging will be provided by the organizer free of charge. Special requirements and additional drinks are to be paid for by the delegates. The costs for board and lodging for additional persons coming with the delegations are to be paid by them without exception. The organizer will assist in making reservations when needed.

Please, do not arrive earlier than 19th June 2017 and do not extend your stay beyond 24th June 2017: there is no way to provide official accommodation prior to and after this specified period of time. Team officials and athletes will be accommodated in 4-8 bed rooms in the Military Academy of the Republic of Belarus.

In Belarus tap water is fully fit for drinking. The use of bottled water is not necessary.

MEDICAL SUPPORT:

The organizer will provide of medical support (first aid) at the competition site. A doctor and an ambulance will be present in order to provide first aid service. The infirmary at the Military Academy will provide medical service round the clock.

Further costs incurred for medical support are to be borne by the participants.

The organizer is not responsible for:

- hospitalizations;
- surgical operations or special treatments;
- repatriation in case of death from illness or accident;
- other expenses on account of illness/accident such as compensations, loss of income, etc.

WEATHER CONDITIONS:

The weather in June can range a daily high temperature from 23°C to 28°C degrees, and a daily low temperature from 12°C to 17°C degrees.

There is a possibility of rain.

EQUIPMENT:

Rifles and ammunition can be provided by the organizer. Delegation arriving without their rifles and ammunition, must notify the organizers in advance about rifles and ammunition requirements in the preliminary application. A certain number of grenades for the competition and training will be provided by the organizer.

HOW TO GET TO MINSK:

- By rail: Minsk railway station
- By plane: Minsk International Airport
- By car: The enclosed map includes the most important road connections to Minsk. <u>Attention</u>: If you plan to use vehicles with military registration numbers and tactical signs, arrangements for immigration are to be made through official diplomatic channels (Military Attaché).

COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF DELEGATION

1. A delegation from the nation that does not confirm their participation by sending the final entry may be excluded from the championship, if their unplanned arrival poses serious problems to the organizing country.

2. The delegation which does not wear military uniform during the opening ceremony of the championship will not be authorized to take part in this championship. This decision will be communicated to the Official CISM Representative.

3. In respect of the statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or ethnic activity during an event of CISM, is expressly forbidden, particularly, the distribution of propaganda documents, photos, brochures, magazines, etc. Any offence will be severely penalized by the expulsion of the delegation.

4. The athletes and other team members have to conform to the rules and instructions of CISM. In case of lack of sporting spirit they will be submitted to trial by the authorities responsible for the organization of the championship that may result in disqualification of the athletes or teams.

I herewith declare to do my utmost to guide the delegation I am responsible for in the spirit of mutual understanding and friendship through sport and to fully respect the official CISM rules. I also declare to promote and enforce the CISM spirit, a spirit that is represented by a friendly attitude towards the other delegations, courtesy towards the organizers and, last but not least, fair play in the competition.
