

## 4. Access to the Location of the Competition

Location of the competition will be the German Armed Forces University Munich.

The cost of travel to and from the host country will be the responsibility of the participating country.



The organizer will ensure the transportation from the point of arrival in the host country to the place of stay and also the transport during the competition.

**Possible points of arrival are: by plane Munich Airport (MUC), by train Munich main station, by bus/car German Armed Forces University Munich (see enclosed road map Annex 3)**

Make sure that International flights arrive/leave from Munich Airport you have chosen.

## **5. Conditions of Stay**

During their stay in Germany the missions will be guests of the German Armed Forces from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> June 2013. Board and lodging will be provided by the organiser free of charge.

Mission members will be accommodated in barracks. Special requirements (telephone, laundry, etc...) and additional drinks are to be paid by the consumers.

**Please, do not arrive earlier than 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2013 and do not extend your stay beyond 8<sup>th</sup> June 2013. There is no way to provide official accommodation prior to and after this specified period of time. Any cost before the foreseen arrival date and/or after the departure date must be covered by the participants.**

## **Medical Support**

The organizer will take care of medical support (first aid) at the competition site. A doctor and an ambulance will be available in order to provide first aid services. Further costs incurred for medical support are to be met by the participants.

The organizer won't be responsible for:

- Hospitalizations,
- Surgical operations or special treatments,
- Repatriation in case of decease by illness,
- Other expenses on account of illness/accident such as compensations, loss of income, etc.

## **6. Regulations of the Championship**

### **Regulations**

The Championship will be governed by the CISM **Regulations** and the CISM Military Pentathlon **Regulations (Edition 2013)**.



Possible exception to the regulations and modifications will be forwarded to all participating nations.

## **Eligibility**

According to the CISM Regulations (CISM Policy Manual, Ch.III, art. 3.19) competitors must be military personnel on active duty within the armed forces of their respective country with an up to date military identity card.

## **Equipment**

Rifles or ammunition cannot be provided by the organiser. Missions showing up without rifles and/or ammunition will not be allowed to compete in the shooting contest. A certain number of throwing projectiles for the competition and the training will be provided by the organiser.

## **Shooting**

Shooting competitions will take place at the Olympic shooting range HOCHBRÜCK, 45 kilometres from the university. Shooting range includes 40 lanes. All facilities are available in the range area. The shooting range is operated with "electronic targeting system". Distance is 300 meters.

### **PRECISION FIRE**

10 rounds in 5 minutes.

## **Obstacle Run**

Obstacle run track is located at German Armed Forces University Munich. Time will be kept electronically. There are two lanes on the track. The floor is coated with tartan. All facilities are available in track area. In obstacle 13 "Banquette and pit" the length of pit is 2.5 m. (regular 3.5 m.).

## **Obstacle Swimming**

Obstacle swimming will be held at the outdoor swimming pool UNTERHACHING, about 2 km from the university. Time will be kept electronically. The pool is 50 meters long. Obstacle swimming will be held in two lanes. All facilities are available at the swimming pool.

## **Throwing**

Throwing will take place at German Armed Forces University Munich. There are 8 lanes;  
5 lanes for the competition, 3 lanes for warm-up. All facilities are available in the throwing area.



## Cross Country

Cross country course is located inside the German Armed Forces university Munich. 8-km run will consist of 2 laps, each lap being 4 kilometers long and the course has mixed ground conditions.

## 7. Uniforms

**Service uniform is required for the opening ceremony, the closing ceremony, and all other official occasions. Permission to wear uniform is granted.**

## 8. Customs and Visa Procedures

Information concerning passports, visas, vaccinations, and health regulations can be obtained from the German Embassy or Consulate serving your country. Applications for visas and for the transportation of weapons and ammunition are the responsibility of the participating delegations. Missions of non-signatory countries of the Schengen Agreement have to apply for Schengen visas at the German Embassy serving your country, at least 4 weeks prior to the International Championship.

## 9. Weather Conditions

Temperatures in June in Munich can range from as high as 26° C to as low as 11° C. Average temperature is about 16.5° C. The probability for rain is at 50%.

**FINAL ENTRY - COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF MISSION**

NATION :

The undersigned Chief of Mission declare that he has read the Article 3.28. of the CISM Policy Manual and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

A. Chief of Mission

1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
2. Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

B. Conduct of a mission

1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition. The mission, who does not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of a Championship, will not be authorised to take part in the Championship. The Official CISM Representative will communicate this decision.
3. In conformity with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious action during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc, is strictly forbidden. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition.
